### Investeren in duurzame ontwikkeling

ASAP is active in 12 villages (15 primary schools) since 1997. Its activities have been delegated to local associations in 2016:

Association pour des Petits Projets Africains (APPA) for village développement projects Société Coopérative
Simplifiée pour la Valorisation
du Miel et Dérivés (VPMD) for
the développement of
production based on raw
material coming from the
villages: honey, shea butter,
locust beans

Association pour le Lycée
Agricole Privé (ALAP) for the

#### Tiles latrines



## Construction of a block of 3 tiled latrines for girls at the primary school.

- Beneficiaries: around 100 girls per school
- Costs for one school: 4.289 euro
- Objective: offer the girls a better surrounding when going to the toilet, easier to clean in case of blood stains.
- Results: in the 3 villages where we have already built such latrine, teachers have seen the girls more at ease to go to the latrine and proud to have their own place.
- Participation of beneficiaries: the villagers will have to provide manpower for the construction (5 men per day during the construction). Value estimated at around 500 euro per village.

Awareness meeting on menstruation and hygiene

A one-day meeting is planned to be held in each of the schools: in the morning for all students on hygiene, and in the afternoon on menstruation for the girls of the last 3 years.

- Beneficiaries: around 50 girls per school for the menstruation meeting and 200 students for the hygiene meeting (total of 750 girls and 3.000 students
- Cost awareness meeting on menstruation: 35 euro for 50 girl
- Cost awareness meeting on hygiene and distribution of soaps: 367 euro per meeting
- Objective: Make all students of the school aware of the importance of good hygiene. Make the girls from the last 3 years of primary school aware of what menstruations are.
- Results: better hygiene from the students and less trauma for the girls when they get their menstruation.
- Participation of beneficiaries: 100 euro per school from the parents association.

# Distribution of washable protection kits for menstruation



We follow **15 schools** and we propose to distribute 40 kits / school via one of the female teachers of the school.

- Beneficiaries: 40 girls per school who already have got their menstruation.
- Total costs: 10 euro per kit
- *Objective*: Help girls with menstruation to be protected during their menstruation.
- Results: better self esteem / confidence for the girls during menstruation, they do not miss school at time of menstruation, better hygiene.
- Participation of beneficiaries: we do not plan any participation from the girls for this project.
